INSTRUCTIONS FOR INTRAVENOUS SEDATION PATIENTS

1. Conscious sedation (IV-administered medicine) is reliable, safe, and very effective. If you have a morning appointment, you may have a cup of tea or coffee and a single piece of toast with jam.
2. Wear comfortable clothing.
3. Be certain to have someone drive you to and from our office.
4. Be certain to call if you have any questions prior to your appointment. Do not be embarrassed to ask a "dumb" question.
